Project idea

Empower elderly HIV patients in self-care by elearning MOOC programme & mobile application

- What we know
 - Once infected with HIV, there is no cure. Avoiding premature death requires lifelong collaboration between people with HIV and their medical and social service providers
 - People suffer from social stigma and isolation and do not participate to education groups
- What we want to demonstrate
 - That empowered patients and enhanced communication between healthcare professionals and patients can change health behaviors, adhere to their medication and improve their well being, quality of life.
- What we want to do
 - To offer both offline and online informational and self-management education support for people living with HIV with a "learning by doing approach" and not a top down course.
- The project
 - A blended learning solution combining e-learning through a MOOC
 - Self-Management Support Tools for People Living with HIV and their Care Providers with face to face workshops held in locations throughout the community and facilitated by trained leaders (patient + healthcare professionals)...
 - Supporting activities include patient testimonials, videos of experts, motivational activities (peer to peer exercises, ex, how to communicate about your disease, etc.), social networking
 - Methodology & tools
 - Board committee including patient associations, patient experts/resources and health care professionals
 - Therapy Management principles and techniques (Education thérapeutique) and motivational interviewing intertwined



Next steps

- Develop a first phase with minimum 4 countries involved (Belgium, The Netherlands, France, Greece)
- Find financial support to start to develop the first priorities
 - Board meetings to define the approach, priorities, define technical infrastructure, detailed scenario.
 - Validate the online survey (educational needs and expectations of PLHIV aged 50 and more)
 - SELF CARE modules (videos, animations etc)
 - Series of thematic webconferences
 - Development of elearning programme : between 150 K€ and 200 K€ (including hosting, multilanguages, multi-users, etc).
 - Develop a 1st phase (masterclasses) to create visibility and partnerships.
- Identify and promote potential partners (mhealth: Emerge, My Smart Age,...).
